Materials and Supplies for Band

_____ 1. Case Name Tag

Every instrument needs a luggage tag on the handle with the student's name on the tag.

_____ 2. Pencils

We will use a mechanical pencil everyday. Have it on your stand.

_____ 3. Three-Ring Binder with clear page protectors

A 1" or 1.5" hardbound notebook is the best, any bigger and the rings wear out.

_____ 4. Instrument Supplies

Please see the next page for a detailed list. Step-up mouthpieces are optional but highly recommended. Think of it this way, the shoes you wore in 5th grade were probably great for you in 5th grade, but don't fit anymore. The same is true for the beginning mouthpieces that came with your instrument.

_____ 5. Have all dates clearly marked in your family calendar.

Use the Semester-at-a Glance & check the online Google/Charms calendar often for updates.

_____ 6. Lyre

A lyre is a little wire stand that grips or hooks on an instrument (except flute which hooks onto your arm). Sousaphones and Percussion will not need these. We will use them at pep rallies in the Gym and in the stands at Football games. The biggest problem with lyres is how they fit on to the instrument. I recommend that each student bring his or her own instrument to the music store to make sure it fits.

_____ 7. Flip Folder

A flip folder clips onto the lyre and is what actually holds the music. Students insert their music into the clear sleeves of the folder so they can see their music.

_____ 8. Metronome and Tuner

The two main ingredients in music are pitch (the notes) and rhythm. Every band uses a metronome in class everyday. It is only fitting that students practice with one at home as well. The easiest way to tell whether a musician sounds good (or bad) is whether they are in tune (or not). Like the metronome, each band uses a tuner every day. It is only fitting that students practice with one at home. There are a few great tuner/metronome apps. The best one is the "[TonalEnergy Tuner](#)"
